NISM is a privately owned international school in Putrajaya, Malaysia. The student body consists of expats from a large number of countries, members of government departments such as the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and private fee paying Malaysians; the school roll is expected to grow to more than 900 over the next few years. NISP follows a British flavoured international curriculum, which includes IPC, IGCSE and IB Diploma.

ICT is fully integrated at all levels in the school; younger children are using iPads, the primary school has access to laptops in trolleys and learners from Year 5 - 13 have their own MacBook Pro laptops which are used across the curriculum. A Boarding House is adding to the diversity of our student population. The school is a fully inclusive environment and has a focus on personalisation of learning.

The Alternative Pathway has been developed with this in mind to accommodate for learners that typically have moderate learning needs and require a personalised and holistic learning program. Many learners in the pathway have needs that are typically on the Autism Spectrum and can be both learning and behavioural.

Consistent with Nexus International School policies, the Speech and Language Therapist will be responsible for:

- Establishing goals and expectations: includes the setting, communication and monitoring of learning goals, standards and expectations, and the involvement of staff and others in the process so that there is clarity and consensus about goals.
- Strategic resourcing: involves aligning resource selection and allocation to priority teaching goals. Includes provision of appropriate expertise through involvement in staff appointments.
- Planning, coordinating and evaluating teaching and the curriculum: direct involvement in the support and evaluation of teaching through regular classroom visits and provision of formative and summative feedback to teachers. Direct oversight of curriculum in the learning area through school wide coordination across classes and year levels and alignment to school goals.
- Promoting and participating in teacher learning and development: leadership that not only promotes but directly participates with teachers in formal or informal professional learning.
- Ensuring an orderly and supportive environment: protecting time for teaching and learning by reducing external pressures and interruptions and establishing an orderly and supportive environment both inside and outside classrooms.

Assessment and Establishing Goals:

- identify the speech and communication difficulty or disorder;
- assess the cause and nature of the problem

Delivering Treatment:

- to follow the standard working hours of the school day
- you will be expected to deliver a social thinking program
- you will be expected to work with a range of learning challenges from MLD to PD with particular focus in the field of Autism
- devise and deliver a suitable treatment programme, working on a one-to-one basis or in groups, to enable each of our learners to improve as much as possible
- manage a caseload while taking into account priority cases, waiting lists, successful outcomes, referral and discharge of programs
- work within a collaborative team to improve the effectiveness of delivery





Monitoring and Reporting Progression

- review and revise the programme as appropriate
- advise parents and teachers on implementing a treatment programme and train other professionals in therapy delivery
- monitor and evaluate the childs progress;
- write confidential client case notes and reports, as well as information for parents and teaching professionals.
