## **KEY OBJECTIVES OF THE POSITION**

Consistent with Nexus International School policies, an IPC Lead Teacher will be responsible for:

- Lead the development of the assessment of knowledge, skills and understanding in IPC including supporting teachers in the planning of, implementation, recording of and reviewing assessment data in IPC.
- Oversee the IPC self review process, monitoring standards in line with the self review and identifying training needs and organising training as required.
- Ensure route map and IPC site is up to date.
- Monitor IPC curriculum goals.

#### Establishing goals and expectations

- Contribute to the development of whole school improvement planning (SIP)
- Contribute to the whole school review of the guiding statements and SIP through further development of The Nexus Way.
- Write your IPC action plan in collaboration with PLT, to align with the SIP.

#### Strategic resourcing and management

- Contribute to whole school decisions about resource allocation.
- Gather and prepare budget requests in line with the SIP.
- Order specialist resources and equipment in line with the SIP.

#### Planning, Coordinating and evaluating teaching and the curriculum

- Contribute to school wide curriculum development through relevant collaboration in alignment with school goals.
- Lead a regular review of the curriculum in your area/Phase in line with the school goals.
- Monitor the overview of IPC goal coverage across Primary.
- Ensure data is collected and reviewed with an impact on learning in IPC.
- Promote a learning focussed culture through regular observations of learning e.g. Looking for Learning, Learning Walks etc
- Ensure team understand and are following the planning process for each phase.
- Promote learning conversations.

#### Promoting and participating in teacher learning and development

- Where appropriate lead whole school and departmental professional learning to further develop learning through the IPC.
- Promote and model best practice in line with the IPC self review.
- Be an active participant in your own continuous professional learning

#### Ensure an orderly and supportive environment

- Represent the views of your team at meetings as part of the whole school community.
