

2D and 3D Shapes

Learners are learning to:

- 1 Initiate play with shapes, recreating the shapes they see in the environment
- 2 Ask questions and make comments on the shapes they see around them
- 3 Select a circle, square rectangle or triangle when asked
- 4 Name a circle, square rectangle or triangle
- 5 Name a heart, diamond
- 6 Guess a shape when given the number of sides
- 7 Describe 2D shapes
- 8 Draw 2D shapes
- 9 Select 3D shape: cone, cyboid, cylinder, pyramid
- 10 Name when asked 3D shapes
- 11 Guess the 3D shape when given the number of faces
- 12 Say which shapes are symmetrical

- 1 Order 3 objects by length
- 2 Order 3 objects by height
- 3 Use simple terms to describe money
- 4 Know coins and notes as money
- 5 Know there are 12 months in the year
- 6 Order the 12 months in the year
- 7 Know there are 7 days in the week
- 8 Order the days of the week
- 9 Correctly use the terms: today, tomorrow, yesterday
- 10 Use simple terms to represent the passing of time
- 11 Order and sequence events
